







How to Connect the HP Chromebook to a Home WiFi Network

<p>STEP 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Select <u>your</u> WiFi network from the list.• Enter <u>your</u> WiFi password.	
<p>STEP 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Once connected, the 'Sign in to your Chromebook' page will appear.• Select next	
<p>STEP 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• This will take you to the DoE account log in page. Type in your <u>DoE User ID</u> Type in your <u>Password</u> Click on the <u>Log in</u> button	
<p>STEP 4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students can access their Google Education account from here.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Please note that Chromebooks allow students to access an online drive. They do not have a hard drive that enables files to be directly stored on the computer. Chromebooks are used to access the internet and cloud based applications such as Google Classroom and Seesaw. Students are required to log in using their DoE username and password. This allows them access to their own files stored in the cloud.
