Dear Parents and Carers,

Yesterday the NSW Premier announced that learning from home will continue until Friday 30th July and our school remains on Level 4 restrictions. Lake Illawarra South Public School staff are preparing for the next two weeks of remote learning. The school remains open for the students of families that need it although families are encouraged to keep their children at home. There will be minimal staff supervision at school.

Parents and carers must drop off and collect students from outside the school gates. Please adhere to physical distancing requirements and avoid gathering outside the school gates. Please be reminded that all visitors to the school site must use the QR codes to check in and out of school premises and wear a mask.

Students who present at school with flu like symptoms will have their parents or carers contacted to collect them.

Please ensure you have completed the Remote Learning Tech Survey. Staff are using this information to allocate the school's tech devices to families. Please understand there is a limited amount of technology that the school can share with the community. We will contact you by telephone to schedule a collection time. Please bear with us while we get this organised.

Years 3 to 6 – a single unit of work provided each week. Students attending school will complete the same activities as provided for those students learning from home.

Students will continue to be able to access their learning from home activities in the following ways:

- Collect a hard copy pack from the school. Drive-by collection will be from 8.10am to 10.00am each Monday. Return any completed hard copy work at this time. Please do not exit your vehicle. Packs can be collected at other times by contacting the school on 42951924.
- Learning from home packs can be downloaded or printed from the school website on the Learning from Home tab. These will be available each Monday morning.
- Via Google Classroom. Activities are scheduled to be released at 8.40am each week day morning. Please be aware the software can take a few minutes to release across all students.

Years K-2 - a single unit of work provided each week. Students attending school will complete the same activities as provided for those students learning from home.

Students will be able to access their learning from home activities in the following ways:

- Collect a hard copy pack from the school. Drive-by collection will be from 8.10am to 10.00am each Monday. Return any completed hard copy work at this time. Please do not exit your vehicle. Packs can be collected at other times by contacting the school on 42951924.
- Learning from home packs can be downloaded or printed from the school website on the Learning from Home tab. These will be available each Monday morning.
- Via SeeSaw (instructions for this will be sent home shortly)
