## Reconciliation Walk

National Reconciliation Week commences on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> May. The theme for 2021 'More than a word. Reconciliation takes action' urges the reconciliation movement towards braver and more impactful action.

On Monday 31<sup>st</sup> May, our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students in Years 3-6 will represent the school at the Shellharbour Council Reconciliation Walk. This will be followed by a **whole school reconciliation walk** on **Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> June**.

After recess, all students and staff will cross Reddall Parade at the front of the school and walk together along the pathway to Reddall Reserve under the supervision of Lake Illawarra South Public School staff. Once at the reserve, each stage will listen to a story about reconciliation and have the opportunity to discuss their thoughts with their peers and teachers. Students and staff will then return to school along the pathway. We will arrive back at school before lunch time.
