Principals Message

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

2012 is just around the corner and planning is well underway. We are very fortunate indeed to be one of few schools in the area, who will have the same number of students, if not more, next year. Most are declining in numbers as the average age of the population increases. However we will continue to have 11 home classes next year and thanks to partnership money, we will continue to have 14 literacy and numeracy classes.

Kindergarten will have the benefit of at least three teachers in each class each day for literacy and numeracy and there will be four teachers, at least twice a week. Interestingly, the largest numbers are in kinder, year one and year two which argues well for the future.

We will continue with Accelerated Literacy across the school and Best Start and the 3 L program in kindergarten. However we will be placing a greater emphasis on written comprehension, sustained text type writing and guided reading. We will stay with Go Maths for another year while we investigate the new National Curriculum. There are four new curriculums to implement over the next few years, so there will be many changes and much to do.

Of course, we will continue to expand our use of technology under the guidance of Mr Evans. There is no end to the possibilities and innovations in this area and we will continue to work with one of our staff members, whom you may not have met, Ms Maxine Green. Ms Green, a former regional PSP consultant with enormous knowledge and talent, is employed by us, using partnership money on Tuesdays. Her role is to act as a literacy coach for our teachers. Under her guidance we are continually examining our teaching practice and improving the way we do things in our classrooms.

One change that we will be sad to see happen, is the loss of both Mrs Louise Mearing and Mrs Leanne Small from our front office. These two ladies have been an absolute pleasure to work with. They have each done so much for our school, our staff, our students and parents and especially me. I will be very sad to see them go and I know that sentiment is echoed by all. However, both Mrs Mearing and Mrs Small are temporary employees, and permanent employees seeking transfer have priority over temporary employees. Hence we will welcome Mrs Gaby Mayo, from Warilla High school to our front office in 2012.
