Survey Results

Thanks to all those families who returned surveys regarding participation in sport and performing arts activities.

The surveys indicate that the majority of families who responded would support the opportunity for students to be involved in knockout sport competitions and performing arts opportunities. The most popular sports were Soccer for both girls and boys, followed closely by Touch Football for boys and girls and Netball for girls.

Parents supported an organised performance through a drama/play utilising a message such as anti bullying. Student participation in Southern Stars and Dance Festival was also strongly supported.

The response to the survey regarding paying for opportunities such as weekly sport and dance activities was not strong. While the majority of surveys returned supported this initiative and were prepared to pay \$30-\$50, not enough parents responded to make a definite commitment for next year. We will look at what opportunities are available again next year.
