I was very pleased to receive a postage package from the Aboriginal Education Council of NSW with an Encouragement award and a \$50 voucher for Byron's excellent factual story. The theme was 'water' and below is the writing Byron submitted.

THE ELAMOSAURAUS WATER DINOSAUR

Elasmosaurus lived a long long time ago. They lived in the water and they have big teeth also green eyes. They grow to about 7m long. On the bottom of them looks like a fin. They also have a long neck like a gentle giant.
