Principal's Message Stranger Danger

With the arrival of warmer weather and school holidays just around the corner, we see many more young children walking to and from school, the park, pools or shops. If your child is walking on their own it is important that you discuss stranger danger and identify safe places within the community. Kidsafensw.org has a range of information and resources parents can use to start this discussion.

BRAVE

In order to assist students in resolving minor conflict at school we use the BRAVE strategy. Students are encouraged to:

- *Be calm* Try to be calm and talk through the problem using a calm voice. If anyone is getting angry, walk away or say "We're getting angry, let's talk about it later".
- *Respect yourself and tell them to stop* Ask the person to stop. Remember to stay calm. Say, "Would you please stop? If you don't, I'll tell a teacher".
- Attempt to ignore If the other person continues the behaviour, try to ignore it by continuing on with your game or activity.
- *Violence is not the answer* Fighting at school is not acceptable and will get you into trouble. Tell the person how you feel, listen to each other or walk away. Calm down and remember there are always two sides to the story.
- *Express your feelings and concerns* Go to a teacher. Ask for help. Express how you are feeling. Talk to your parents. If the problem continues, keep expressing your concerns until things get better.
