Return to School, 2018

Important Dates:

Staff return – Monday 29th January Years 1-6 return – Tuesday 30th January Kindergarten commences – Wednesday 31st January (staggered start times)

On the first day of school students will be directed to line up under the COLA at the morning bell. From here we will direct students to classrooms with teachers.

For the first week students will return to their 2017 classes with their 2017 teacher (where possible). This is a temporary arrangement while class structures and numbers are considered. During this time students will participate in lessons that focus on:
