Choose either A or B.

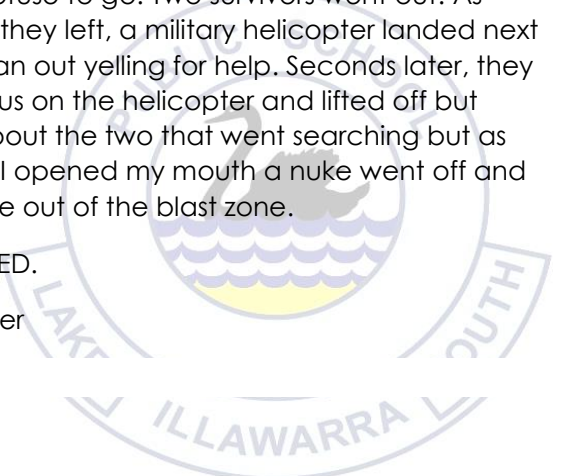
- A. Leave camp to search
