STUDENT SAFETY

Safety of our students is a priority at Lake Illawarra South Public School. We need to be aware of any people that are within the school grounds at all times. All parents and carers are reminded that when entering the school grounds during the day they must report to the front office. This includes collecting students early or assisting in classrooms. If you need to come to the school for any reason,

please report to the office. We appreciate your support with this matter.

COVID-SMART MEASURES

With COVID-19 and flu circulating in our community and positive numbers increasing, all Department of Education schools will continue to implement layered COVID-smart measures in Term 3 to prioritise student and staff wellbeing and remain operational. This includes strongly advising mask wearing, distributing Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) to our staff and students, maximising natural ventilation and enhanced cleaning.

Students with cold and flu-type symptoms must stay at home and conduct a RAT test. If symptoms develop during the school day, parents and carers will be contacted to collect students from school.

Students who test positive must have their result reported to NSW Health and the school office and commence isolation for 7 days from the date of the positive test.

Students who are close contacts are allowed to attend school if they are not symptomatic. They must inform the school that they are a close contact, and it is recommended that a mask is worn indoors. All close contacts should conduct and return a negative RAT each morning before attending school for 5 days. To support this process, school will send home 5 RATs per student when our delivery has arrived. Visitors to the school must inform staff if they are close contacts and wear a mask indoors at all times. Close contacts who are symptomatic should isolate at home and continue to test each day.

STUDENT UNIFORMS

Please remember students are required to wear full school uniform, including a school jumper, navy track pants and white, grey or black socks. Socks with visible logos are not acceptable. We also ask you label your child's uniforms and other belongings clearly so that any lost items can be returned promptly. Parent cooperation with this would be most appreciated.

Please note that if you are looking for second-hand uniforms, these can be purchased at the front office.

KINDERGARTEN 2023

Enrolments for Kindergarten 2023 are now being accepted. Applications for siblings of currently enrolled students can be submitted for consideration by the 'out of area' enrolment panel. If you are a local enrolment, you are able to enrol online or call to the school office and collect an Enrolment Pack.

To enrol online, go to the school website https://lakeillaws-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/;

Click on Enrolment at the top of the page

Click on Apply for enrolment online

Read the information and then go to the bottom of the page and *Enrolling for 2023*.

Type in your residential address; if your address is in the school's local area you will be able to click on the Apply to Enrol button. This takes you to the Privacy Agreement.

Click *I agree* to the Privacy Agreement and continue

Add your email address and tick I'm not a robot and click continue; you will be sent a verification code to your email address.

Enter the code and click verify and proceed to the Enrolment Form.

If you are applying to enrol a sibling of a current 'out of area' student, you will need to call the school office to register your child and collect the required enrolment form for completion.

If you do not live within the Lake Illawarra South Public School catchment area, you are welcome to submit a non-local enrolment application for consideration by our 'out of area' enrolment panel.

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING

This week's Positive Behaviour for Learning focus is Respect – Use friendly words and actions. This skill enables students to be a good friend and treat their peers as they would like to be treated. It is an

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important skill to enable all students to work and play in a positive environment.

STUDENT ABSENCES

Please remember to supply information to the school when your child is absent. This can be done via email, a handwritten note or responding to the absence SMS notification. SMS notifications are sent each day from 11am. If you receive a notification, please reply with a **specific** explanation (e.g. tummy bug, persistent cough, vomiting) that will then be uploaded to our system.

Please be aware 'sick' is not a specific explanation and as such will be marked as 'unjustified'.

All absences are required to be explained within 7 days.



If you are planning on taking your child out of school for 5 days or more, you must complete an Extended Leave Application form. These are available from the front office. Once you have submitted the form, it will be passed to Mrs Simula for consideration. Approved leave applicants will then be issued with an Extended Leave Certificate which needs to be produced if requested by police or Home School Liaison Officers. Please note, these absences are counted in the student's absence tally.
